





## Photo submissions for a contest under the concept "Grow Global Photo Story"

## Photograph contest rules:

- 1. The photo contest is open only to students currently enrolled at Prince of Songkla University. Entrants may be of any educational level, faculty, gender and age.
- 2. The entrant submitting the photo must provide all the required information about the photograph (location and a brief background story about the picture), along with the required information on the attached "Photo Contest Submission Form" provided by the International Affairs Office, Educational Service Division. This information will be considered for the contest judgment.
- 3. The submitted photograph must have been taken during the entrant's overseas travel experience, and the entrant must be the sole author of the submitted photograph. Photos from other sources will be immediately disqualified, and the entrant may be denied to participate in any other activities of the International Affairs Office.
- 4. The photograph must be submitted as a digital file, taken with any type of digital camera (DSLR, mirrorless, compact, drone, action camera, smartphone etc.). There is no restriction on the date of the photograph.
- 5. The resolution of the file must be at least A3 (minimum  $2560 \times 1920$  pixels, or  $11.7 \times 16.5$  inches), in JPEG format only.
- 6. Photos must show no watermark, photo credit or any graphic; no borders of any color. Photos in violation of this rule will be disqualified without exception.
- 7. Slight retouching, such as color adjustment and cropping out extraneous details, is allowed, as long as the content is not significantly altered. Significance is upon the judges' discretion.
- 8. One entrant can submit only one photograph entry.
- 9. Photographs submitted must not have been the winners of any contest before, including public events and internal contests of an association, club, or any other organization. This also includes images taken with similar elements as the winning photograph, such as multiple shots at the same time; minor composition changes or cropped versions of the original winning image; or a photograph imitating the composition of other award-winning entries. This condition is evaluated upon the discretion of the judges.
- 10. The submitted photograph must not be under any third-party copyright, nor being sold as a stock photo.







11. Entrants must keep the original, unedited version of the submitted photograph, in addition to a high-resolution

edited version (RAW/JPEG). The judges may request these files.

12. The organizer has the right to select the photos submitted for the contest to be displayed in various places,

and to publish the photos and related information. The award-winning image files will be the property of the

organizers, but the copyright of all submitted images remains with the entrant. The organizer retains the rights

specified herein for only three years from the date of award presentation.

13. Copyright holders grant Prince of Songkla University the right to use and distribute submitted photos for

activities in all media, including social media, online and print, and all promotional and educational activities for

and under the auspices of Prince of Songkla University, without any remuneration being due to photo copyright

owners. The name of the entrant will be indicated every time the entrant's photo is used.

14. If the entry does not comply with the rules specified above, the entry is disqualified, and any rights pertaining

this contest are voided immediately. Ignorance of the rules is not considered a valid excuse, and the judgment of

the committee is considered final.

15. The photograph needs to be submitted by email to <a href="mailto:psugrowglobal@gmail.com">psugrowglobal@gmail.com</a>, along with the attached

"Photo Contest Submission Form". The deadline for submission is 7 January 2020.

Awards:

1. The winner: 2,000 Baht

2. Awards for second place: 1,000 Baht

3. Cheering prizes: 500 Baht

Note: Awardees also receive Certificates of Achievement

All contestants will receive Certificates of Participation
