

Prince of Songkla University Announcement Subject: Extension of work-from-home period for staff to reduce the risk of a new wave of Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) outbreak

The Prince of Songkla University Announcement, Subject: Work-from-home guidelines for staff to reduce the risk of a new wave of Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) outbreak (Issue no. 7) has been issued to curb the mass outbreak of COVID-19, which had become more wide-spread and severe.

Prince of Songkla University has also announced a request for the cooperation of PSU staff to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 by avoiding eating together, partying or risky behavior, gathering in crowded areas, talking in the elevator, wearing a mask at all times when staying outdoors, social distancing, strict practice of personal hygiene (e.g. frequent hand washing with soap, alcohol gel), and strict adherence to orders or announcements of the Provincial Communicable Disease Committee.

To further reduce the risk of COVID-19, the work-from-home period for PSU staff is extended to 16 May 2021.
