

Prince of Songkla University Announcement

Subject: Measures for monitoring and control of Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) outbreak among staff and students at Prince of Songkla University, Hat Yai Campus

In accordance with the dynamic situation in Songkhla province, the number of people infected with the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) keeps increasing in the industrial sector, immigration detention centers, and the three southern border provinces. Therefore, staff and students on Prince of Songkla University's Hat Yai Campus are requested to strictly comply with the following measures:

- 1. Staff and students are requested to refrain from traveling to high-risk areas in Songkhla province, neighboring community areas, infected industrial factories (as reported by the Songkhla Provincial Public Health Office authorities) and the three southern border provinces.
- 2. PSU staff staying with family members or with anyone working in the risk areas listed in Clause 1 are requested to work from home for 14 days.
- 3. PSU staff in proximity to risk groups must practice self-quarantine at home, monitor for symptoms, and fill out a COVID-19 infection risk assessment form through the link: http://www.personnel.psu.ac.th/page5.html. People deemed at risk will be contacted by hospital staff for screening.
- 4. All are requested to adhere to DMHTT principles: Distancing, Mask wearing, Hand washing, Testing, and Thaichana application usage, and act accordingly.
