



**Prince of Songkla University Announcement**  
**Subject: Measures for monitoring and contact tracing of high-risk groups**  
**for Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) outbreak prevention**

Due to a recent nationwide COVID-19 infection resurgence, Prince of Songkla University specifies the following measures for control and prevention:

1. Students and staff at Prince of Songkla University need to adhere to the following protective measures: wearing a medical or regular mask every time when leaving their accommodation; avoiding crowded places; washing hands frequently with soap or alcohol gel; eating hot food and using serving spoons; avoiding hand contact with eyes, nose or mouth. A medical mask or regular mask also needs to be worn indoors (buildings, workplace or classrooms).

2. Those with symptoms of respiratory disease must act as described below.

- Those exhibiting cold-like symptoms such as fever, runny nose, cough, but not having a high-risk history need to take a break, treatment at home, and then proceed according to Item 1 until recovery.

- Those exhibiting cold-like symptoms and having a high-risk history (e.g. recent contact with migrant laborers in high-risk areas, or visit to high-risk areas) need to be screened at the hospital.

- Those with suspected respiratory symptoms such as fever, sore throat, dry cough, body aches, inability to smell, rapid breathing, tiredness; even without a high-risk history, need to undergo screening at the hospital.

3. Students and staff who travelled to Samut Sakhon province after 1 December 2020 are considered to be at risk. They need to notify their supervisor to consider self-quarantine and work from home for 14 days from the date of leaving the risk area.

4. Traveling to high-risk locations specified by the Ministry of Public Health needs to be avoided until further notice.

5. Social events or crowded activities should not be organized. However, in case of necessity, permission from the President or Vice President of the Campus is required.
