B.TM. : Bachelor of Thai Traditional Medicine

Four years curricular structure which includes the study of basic and medical sciences along with the core subjects of Thai Traditional Medicine; Thai medicine, Thai pharmacy, Thai midwifery and Thai massage

M.TM. : Master of Thai Traditional Medicine

D.TM. : Doctor of Thai Traditional Medicine
