Requirements for graduation

Requirements for graduation depends on your plan of study

What is your plan of study?

Master: A1, A2, B

PhD : 1.1, 1.2, 2.1, 2.2



Requirement on thesis and coursework

Master degree: at least 36 credits of study

- Plan A1: Research only--Thesis ≥36 credits.
 may take some course works as AUDIT (grading: S or U)
- Plan A2: course work ≥ 18 credits (grading as A-E)
 thesis ≥ 12 or 18 credits.
- Plan B: course work ≥ 30 credits (grading as A-E)
 minor thesis: 3-6 credits





- Plan 1.1: research only program for those with Master degree
 ≥ 48 credits for thesis
- Plan 1.2: research only program for those with Bachelor degree
 ≥72 credits for thesis

- Plan 2.1: for those with Master degree
 ≥12 credits of course work+ ≥ 36 credits for thesis
- Plan 2.2: for those with Bachelor degree
 ≥24 credits of course work + ≥ 48 credits for thesis

Duration of Study

Master: 2 years (official length of program)

max duration: not more than 5 years



Doctor of Philosophy: 3 or 4 years (official length of program)

not more than 6 years (those with a master's degree: Plan 1.1+2.1)

not more than 8 years (those with a bachelor's degree: Plan 1.2+2.2)

Number of Credits Per Semester: not more than 15 credits (with the consent of academic or thesis advisor, > 15 credits are allowed)

Six major requirements for graduation Master program:

1) Completion of all courses as required by the program with GPA ≥ 3.00 (except for plan A1: research only, no GPA)

3) Pass the thesis proposal examination

4) Pass thesis examination + submit thesis



- 5) Publish research work from thesis (more on next slide)
- -Research article with findings from your thesis as main components
- -Not a review article
- -Time consuming process: Well-planned on this with your advisor

6) Other conditions as required by the programs. (consult your program director or advisor)

Minimum requirement for publication: General requirement for master program

A1: one article in an accepted peer review journal



A2: publish thesis work as one full paper (not just abstract) in conference proceedings or

publish 1 article in an accepted peer reviewed journal

Note:

- 1. Some programs may have a higher requirement (such as inter publication)
- 2. If you got <u>scholarships</u> with a higher requirement on publication (such as inter publication), it will become graduation requirement.

Six major requirements for graduation PhD Study:

1) Completion of all courses as required by the program with GPA \geq 3.00 (except for plan 1.1 and 1.2)

Master's Degree (International Program) and Ph.D. Level



- 3) Pass the Qualifying Exam**
- Assess student's competency to become a PhD candidate (ability to conduct doctoral research)



- 4) Pass proposal examination+thesis examination + submit thesis
- 5) Publish research work from thesis**
- -Research article with findings from your thesis as main components
- -Not a review article
- 6) Other conditions as required by the programs (consult your program director or advisor)

Minimum requirement for publication: General requirement: PhD. study



- 1.1 and 1.2: two publications in accepted peer reviewed journals
- 2.1 and 2.2: one publication in accepted peer reviewed journals

Note:

- 1. <u>Some programs</u> may have a higher requirement (such as inter publication)
- 2. If you got scholarships with a higher requirement on publication (such as inter publication), it will become graduation requirement.

(definition of accepted peer reviewed journals: same as that of Master program)

- Those in research only program, please register for "audit" (grading is in S or U)
