
Long Live Her Majesty Queen Sirikit the Queen Mother

HRH Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn opened administrative building of the Southern Thailand Science Park













Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn has kindly presided over the opening ceremony for the administrative building of the Southern Thailand Science Park (Songkhla Province) at Thung Yai Sub-district, on 24 September 2020. Her Royal Highness was warmly welcomed by Adjunct Professor Dr. Anek Laothamatas, Minister of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation; Assistant Professor Dr. Niwat Keawpradub, President of Prince of Songkla University; the heads of government departments and administrators; and PSU faculty and staff.

After the opening ceremony, Her Royal Highness was presented with an informative report about the Southern Thailand Science Park by Asst. Prof. Kamron Pitaks, Director of the Science Park. The presentation was followed by an overview of outstanding regional innovations, presented by Asst. Prof. Sunton Wongsiri, M.D., PSU Vice President for Research and Innovation.

One of the innovative products presented was the GISS Unit, Slurry Casting Technology (GISCO Co., Ltd.), a machine that represents a new world-class technology known as slurry casting. The technology involves a semi-solid casting method with exceptional physical properties, which extends the life expectancy of the mold and reduces the time for casting parts per piece, compared to the current method of casting metal parts. As a result, the production cost for metal parts is lower, and the cast parts are of higher quality.

Another innovative product presented at the auspicious event was the screening kit for COVID-19 virus infection (PSU COVID-19 Rapid Test), used for screening patients in high-risk groups quickly. The screening relies on Immunochromatography (ICT), detecting antibodies against both IgM and IgG specific to the proteins of the COVID-19 pathogen. The ICT method is best suitable for this purpose because it is easy, fast, stable, sensitive and highly specific. The product is intended to be utilized both for the early detection of infection and for monitoring immune response development. The test requires 15-20 microliters (2-3 drops) of fingertip blood sample, plasma or serum, and is completed in 15-20 minutes. Moreover, the assay can be kept at room temperature for several months.

Her Royal Highness then kindly observed exhibitions of outstanding innovations in various fields such as rubber, health and food science, and then graciously planted a Sri Trang tree, whose flower is the symbol of Prince of Songkla University.

The administrative building of the Southern Thailand Science Park includes a laboratory, tools for research and development, analysis testing and certification service, promoting the establishment and growth of the scientific business, in addition to providing a full range of services by the Innovation Design Center, Office of Industrial Cooperation (OIL), Coordination Center for the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation under the cooperation between the titular office and the Southern Thailand Science Park by Prince of Songkla University, Walailak University and Thaksin University.

The Southern Thailand Science Park was established as a service center to link the knowledge from universities to the private sector in the southern region, in order to develop resources and research basic infrastructure in the public sector for maximum benefit, with the additional aim to strengthen the technological advances and increase the competitiveness of the region.

PSU lecturer is #1 in "Southeast Asian Women 2020 in Science and Education"







Asst. Dr. Pimchanok Buapet, a lecturer at PSU's Department of Biology, Faculty of Science, was selected as #1 in the "Southeast Asian Women 2020 in Science and Education" category by the Young Southeast Asia Leaders Initiative (YSEALI) Women's Leadership Academy Alumni Network. This year, a total of 80 people were recognized in 16 disciplines across ten countries.

Dr. Pimchanok, who also serves as the Director of Coastal Oceanography and Climate Change Research Center at PSU, revealed that she initially joined the YSEALI Southeast Asian Women Network when she participated in a workshop on assessing the carbon storage potential of seagrass ecosystems. Dr. Pimchanok recognized the importance of building a network within the region, because climate change is a global problem that requires cooperation and communication of not just researchers, but every sector that has a role in mitigating climate change.

"I am delighted that the work of the Coastal Oceanography and Climate Change Research Center is recognized on the international stage. I want to thank Prince of Songkla University and its Research and Development Office for supporting the establishment of the research center in 2017, playing a pivotal role in driving research related to climate change and coastal ecosystem issues. The current goal of research studies in the seas and the coast is to meet sustainable development goals in climate change management and in the exploitation of oceans and marine resources, as described in the United Nations Development Agreement Framework", Dr. Pimchanok explained.



Prince of Songkla University, represented by Asst. Prof. Sunton Wongsiri, M.D., Vice President for Research and Innovation, has entered collaboration with the Office of Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation, along with 14 leading higher education institutions, to set guidelines for enhancing the quality and standards of higher education institutions. Their aim is to reach international quality and standards through the quality assurance system of the world's leading ranking institution: QS Stars.

QS Stars rating, an innovative system for evaluating the performance of higher education institutions around the world, could incentivize Thai higher education institutions to raise their level of quality to international standards acceptance. Quality assessment is carried out by measuring indicators in various areas, including research, teaching, employability, internationalization, facilities, innovation and social responsibility. Higher education institutions with potential and readiness have been invited to enter the quality assurance system, and as a result, currently 14 higher education institutions indicated their intention undergo quality assurance through QS Stars rating.

COVID-19: joint webinars between the UoB and PSU

The University of Bahrain (UoB), in cooperation with Prince of Songkla University (PSU), organized two webinars concerning the COVID-19 situation.

The first webinar, held on 8 July 2020, focused on the topic "Overcoming Impact of COVID-19 through Digital Transformation". The event featured experts from outstanding institutions in Australia and Singapore, alongside experts at PSU, all talking about various approaches to managing COVID-19 impact and recovery plans using digital tools, and why they are essential for the education and economic sectors.

A week later, the second webinar tackled the topic "Healthcare Resiliency during COVID-19", where specialists from PSU and the UoB discussed the implications of the pandemic on the healthcare system, shared their practical experiences in taking care of COVID-19 patients, and highlighted technological applications that provide the means necessary to manage this pandemic.

The two events provided the target audience with practical knowledge and experiences to help their institutions minimize and recover from the negative impact of the ongoing pandemic. Furthermore, the successful joint hosting of the webinars represents a milestone in the history of fruitful cooperation between the UoB and PSU.
